

On the occasion of the next **Marie Sklodowska-Curie Actions (MSCA)** conference which will take place in Mons (BE) on 18th-19th April, a call for posters is launched.

People get the opportunity to showcase their research and their research careers in a poster or another medium. The final idea is that conference attendees learn something about specific research but also and at least as important that the diversity of posters, other used media and participants show the conference attendees that there is no specific career path that is most preferable but that there is a very wide range of possibilities in research and research careers and they are all precious.

All topics (all disciplines but also stories with links to policy making, research governance, success stories or just failure stories of individual researchers, ...) are eligible. Applicants can work in the academia, in public service, in companies, or in NGOs, etc.

Selected posters will be displayed during the whole conference. On the first day of the conference, participants will be given the opportunity to present their posters during the breaks.

A poll will be organized during the conference (only for physical attendees). The two most voted-for posters will be announced at the end of the event. They will receive an award.

Submission process

This call for posters is open to all professionals promoting and/or working on science in research institutes, higher education institutions, national agencies, funding agencies, NGOs, etc.

Applications (maximum 2 pages) must include the following:

- A description of the institution coordinating the project
- A brief description of the project
- The link with the topic of the conference: Researchers' careers: multiple pathways.

Criteria for posters:

- Available under CC By license
- Royalty-free, so that they can be distributed for promotional purposes, including on social media and on the website
- Written in English.

Please note the following deadlines:

- Submission deadline: 15/03/2024
- Announcement of the selection: 29/03/2024
- Notification of the candidates' attendance (to the organizers): 04/04/2024

The authors of the best 20 posters will have the opportunity to bring their printed posters and display them during the conference. Their travel costs and accommodation will be covered by the organizers (with a maximum amount of 750 \in).

Selection process

Submitted posters will undergo a thorough selection process carried out by the organizers of the MSCA conference together with the European Commission.

Key selection criteria will be clarity, relevance to the topic of the conference, timeliness, novelty and originality.

Award

Two prizes will be awarded:

- the public award
- the jury award
